DID YOU KNOW?

Children’s Church takes place during the sermon time, following our children’s sermon. The children, from ages 4 to fifth grade learn the same topic as the sermon.

Communion is monthly, usually the first Sunday of the month. It is an open table, anyone who trusts in Jesus is invited to the table. Children are welcomed when their parents feel they are able to appreciate that it reminds them of God’s love for them.

Feed the Hungry Offering is usually on the first Sunday of the month. This extra offering goes a half to the Pack a Bag program that provides weekend meals at Shuford Elementary; a quarter to the Corner Table the soup kitchen in

Newton, and a quarter to Eastern Carawba Christian Cooperative Ministry (ECCCM)

The Parish Nurse will take your blood pressure and answer health related questions. She is available usually on the third Sunday after worship, or on request.

A Healing Service is a special prayer service for you or someone else, for healing of the body or spirit. It usually takes place on the fourth Sunday after worship.

Men’s Fraternity is a video driven study for men. It meets on Mondays at 7:00 in the fellowship hall.
